South Carolina Legal Services will be at Chapin Memorial Library to assist in preparing **YOUR Simple Will** and **Advance Directives** legal forms, which may include: Healthcare Power of Attorney; Durable Power of Attorney; and DNR (Do Not Resuscitate) forms for residents of South Carolina. **To qualify for this FREE legal assistance, you must be at least 60 years of age; certain income and asset restrictions apply.**
