Child ID Program

Child IDs are created using the EZ Child ID System, the nation's most comprehensive digital fingerprinting child identification system. In only three to five minutes, a Child ID card is printed for each parent or guardian **free** of charge. Child ID cards feature a child's photo, fingerprints, contact information, and other pertinent data needed by the police in case of an emergency. **Please note that children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.** No child's information or pictures are electronically retained. All data is automatically erased after the Child ID is printed.
