- Scanning, printing and faxing.

We all realize that this is an unusual situation, however, we are trying to make it as easy as possible to welcome you back at the library. **We are committed to the well-being of all as we welcome you back to the library.** We are carefully reopening, with the goal to keep everyone safe and healthy. **The following procedures will be followed:**

- **BODY TEMPERATURE CHECK:** All staff and patrons are screened for fever prior to library entry. Anyone with a reading over 100° F is not admitted.
- **WEARING FACE COVERINGS:** All staff and patrons are encouraged to wear face masks.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Floor markings to help keep 6 feet distance at all times.
- **HAND SANITIZING STATIONS:** Available throughout the library.
- **FREQUENT DISINFECTING:** Hourly disinfecting of common areas. Computers will be sanitized between each use.
- **MATERIAL SANITIZATION:** All returned materials will be in quarantine for 7 days, then carefully sanitized before being placed back into circulation.

Ancestry Library Edition

Traditionally only accessible inside the library, Ancestry Library Edition access is **temporarily** expanded to library card-

holders at home, courtesy of ProQuest and its partner Ancestry. Remote access will be available until the end of April and will be re-evaluated monthly by the provider. You only need to enter your library card number to validate and begin.



Rosetta Stone

The popular online language learning platform uses the immersion method of language learning. Language learners can choose from over 30 languages accessible from anywhere, anytime.



Universal Class

Hundreds of online continuing education classes facilitated by dedicated instructors sharing their knowledge on almost any imaginable topic. Some

Flipster

Read or flip through digital magazines right in your web browser. No checkout limits and no due dates. You can download the app to read all of the magazines offline. 50 different titles are available.

Get access to both our Palmetto Consortium collection and our exclusive Chapin Advantage collection of eBooks and AudioBooks available through the Libby app.



Axis360

Axis360 is an exclusive eBook and eAudio download service for Chapin Library cardholders. The checkout limit is 5 titles per borrower at a time with a 14 day checkout period.
